
Spring Welly Walk - 8th February

Read Write Inc

This term Read Write Inc will be slightly different for Foundation Stage children. The children have been busy learning their set 1 sounds and will now be working in smaller groups based on their level of phonic knowledge. These groups will continue to help the children revise the set 1 sounds as they begin to learn set 2 sounds. Each group will focus on developing their phonic knowledge enabling them to read and write. If your child is unsure of some of set 1 sounds you can support them at home with the small green home learning RWInc book, playing eye spy, spotting sounds in the shops.
