Key Vocabulary

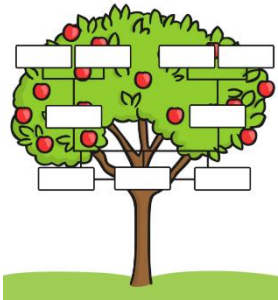

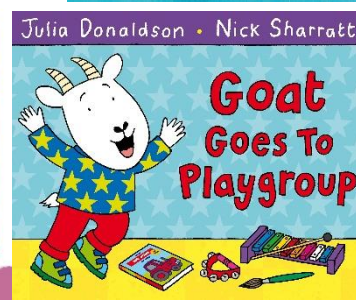
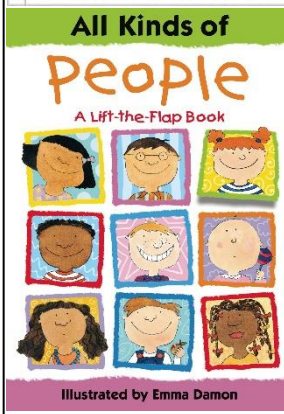
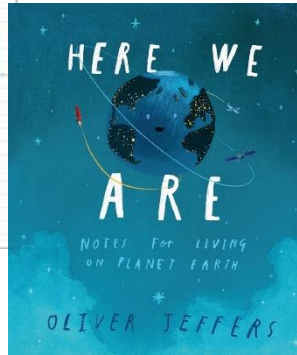
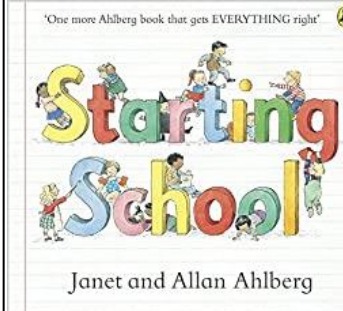
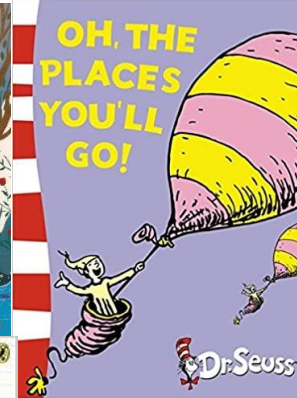
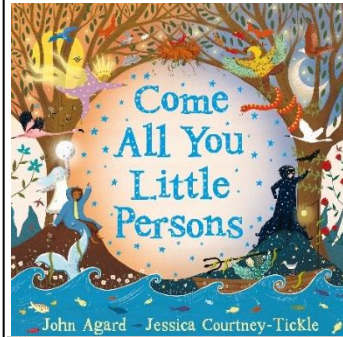


My Family Tree
