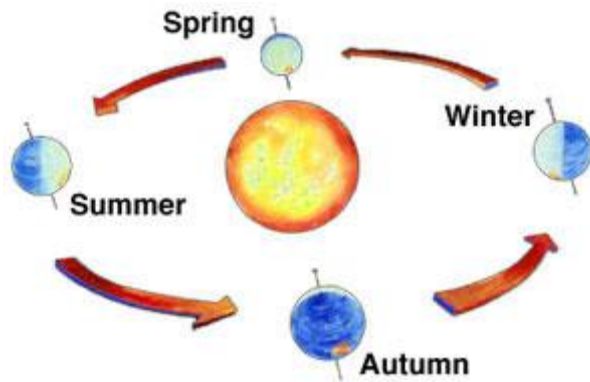




Winter		Spring			Summer			Autumn			Winter
