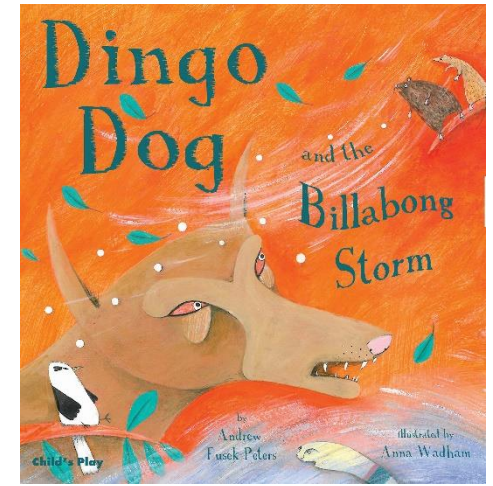
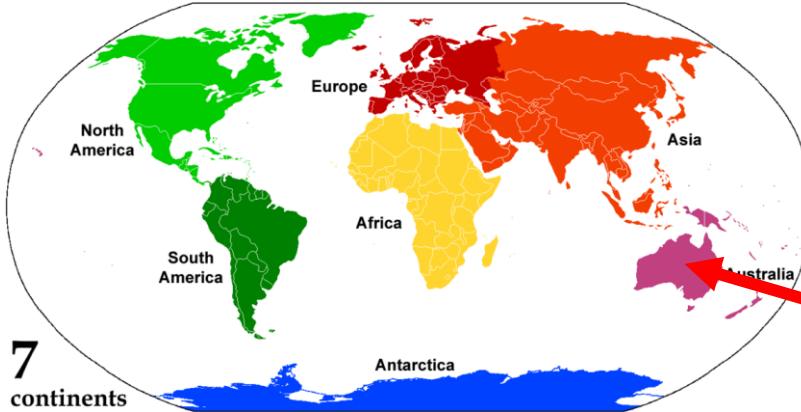
Key Vocabulary

Aboriginal, billabong, bush, desert, climate, equator, continent, ocean

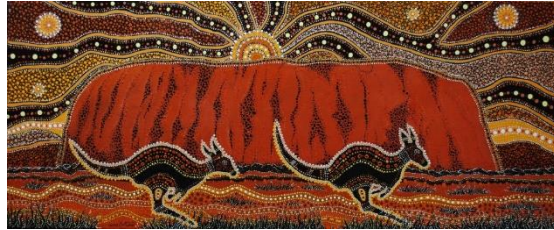
Key words
