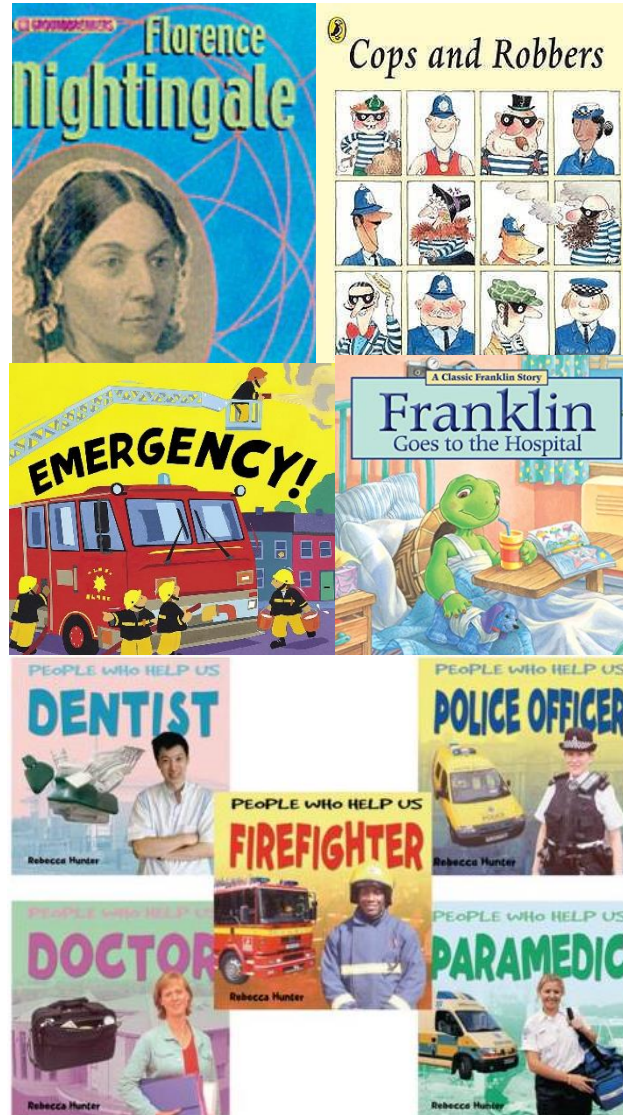
## Key Vocabulary

## Some of the People Who Help Us

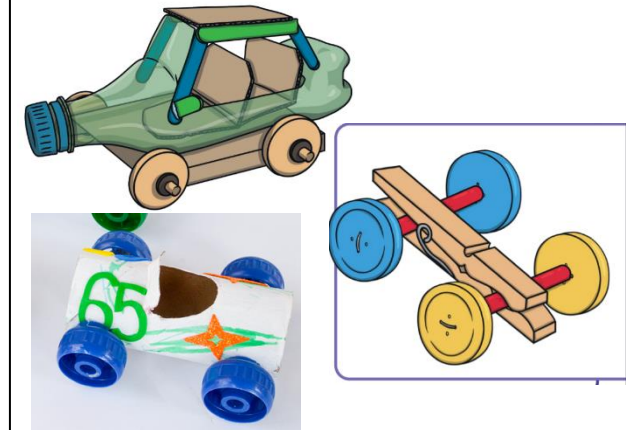
Builders	Help build houses and other places
