

**Key Stage 1 vocabulary:**

carve	Using tools to scrape material away.
pinch	Squeezing a material into the desired shape.
roll	Using a board or fingers to roll a material into a desired shape.
join	Using sticking materials to attach materials together.
form	Using materials to create a 3D piece of artwork.

**Key Stage 2 Vocabulary:**

surface	The area of the material you are working on.
sculpture	A 3D piece of artwork.
sculptor	An artist who creates a 3D piece of artwork.
properties	The way the material feels, acts and changes when you work with it.

**Artists studied:**

**Oak – Molly Williams**



Williams uses different materials to twist and roll, creating interesting shapes in her artwork.

**Willow – Henry Moore**

Moore uses form to explore shape in an abstract way. He would be interesting to inspire sculpture.



**Holly – Antony Gormley**



Gormley uses a range of materials to create his artworks, usually exploring anatomy.
