



We can do some experiments to measure how the season has changed over the term.

We can measure the amount of rain, how bright the sun is and how clear our shadows are.

What does this tell us about the seasons?



During autumn, the day will get darker at an earlier time.

The seasons are a **cycle**. That means when they get to the end, the seasons start again.



Over the term we will see summer change into autumn.

What changes can you see?

Why do we see these changes?

The weather changes as the seasons do. Some weather types you only see in a certain season.
