coast, beach, seaside, cliff, ocean

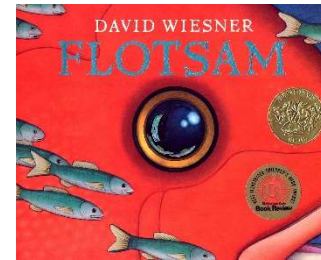
beach	Land next to the sea. Usually sandy or pebbly. People like to visit for day trips or a holiday.
