seasons	There are four seasons in each year
spring	The weather starts to get warmer, leaves and flowers begin to grow and baby animals i.e. lambs are around.
summer	The weather gets hotter, trees are full of leaves and there are lots of flowers bees, butterflies and other insects.
weather	The temperature outside, wind direction and strength, rain, cloud, snow and sun
daylight	When it is light outside. The amount of daylight changes with each season.

The seasons are a cycle. That means when they get to the end, the seasons start again.
