Key Vocabulary

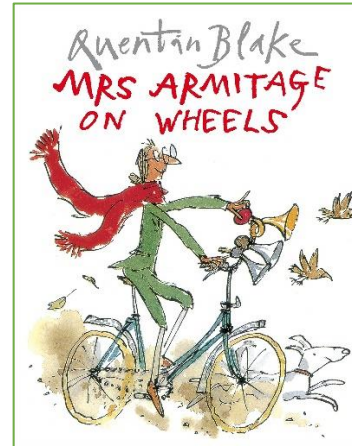
modes of transport, travel, invention, locomotive, astronaut, shuttle, fuel

fuel	The material needed to power a mode of transport.
invention	A new thing that has been created for the first time.
locomotive	A powerful vehicle that pulls carriages on a railway track. They can be steam or diesel powered.
modes of transport	Different ways to travel. Cars, trains, boats, bikes are all modes of transport.
shuttle	A space rocket. The shuttle breaks away once the astronauts are in space.
travel	Moving around on different modes of transport.

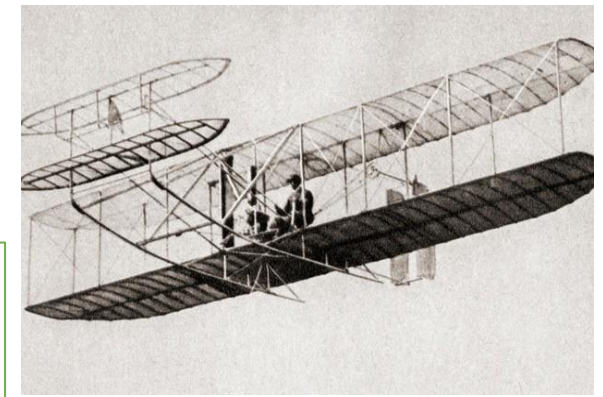
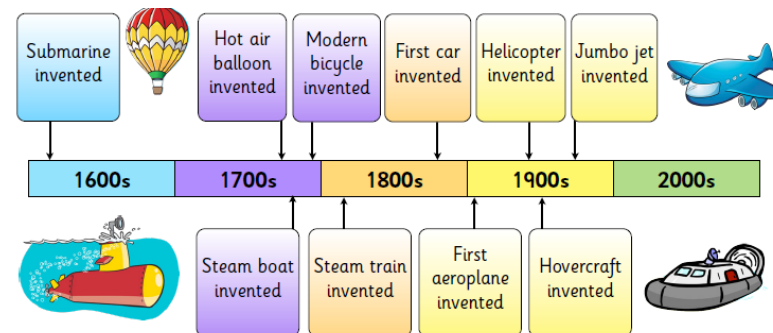
