

Key Stage 1 vocabulary:

collage	Overlapping materials to create an effect.
weaving	Crossing one material over another.
running stitch	Moving your thread over and under the fabric with a needle.
sewing	Making patterns or marks with a needle and thread.

Key Stage 2 Vocabulary:

tie-dye	Using ink to change the colour of a fabric that has been tied up.
cross stitch	To sew a series of X shapes creating an overall pattern or image.
embellish	To decorate a design with beads, sequins or other materials.
collaborate	To work together to create a piece of art.

Willow – Victoria Villasana

Villasana uses photos of inspirational people and embellishes them with stitches and colour.

Techniques:

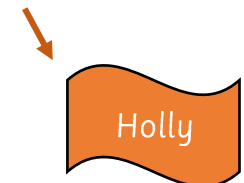
Texture
