Geography Skills

- Use information books/pictures as sources.

RE Skills

- Talk about what Christians, Muslims and Jewish people believe.
- Identify key holy texts and some holy artefacts.

Computing Skills

- Label objects
- Identify that objects can be counted
- Describe objects in different ways
- Count objects with the same properties
- Compare groups of objects
- Answer questions about groups of objects

Science Skills

- Describe what animals need to survive.
- Explain that animals grow from offspring into adults.
- Describe life cycles of some animals.
