History- Terrible Tudors

- Use evidence to build up a picture of a past event.
- Choose relevant material to present a picture of one aspect of life in time past.
- Ask a variety of questions.
- Use the library and internet for research
- Communicate their knowledge through: discussion, drawing, pictures, drama/role play, making models, writing and using ICT.
- Observe small details- artefacts, pictures etc.
- Place the time studied on a timeline.

Computing – Photo editing

- Use digital devices to record sound.
- Explain that audio can be changed through editing.
- Show that different types of audio can be combined and played together.
- Explain that digital images can be changed
- Describe how images can be changed for different uses.

Science Skills (Electricity)

- Record findings using scientific language, drawings, labelled diagrams,.
- Raise simple, further questions which could be investigated.
- Use, read, and spell scientific vocabulary correctly and with confidence, using their growing word reading and spelling knowledge.
- Present data in a variety of ways to help in answering questions.
- Report and present their results and conclusions to others in written and oral forms with increasing confidence.
