

physical geography	The branch of geography deals with natural features.		
cay	A low-lying island or reef made from coral, rock or sand. Often small and uninhabited by people.		
tourist	A person who visits a place for pleasure.		
tourism	The business of providing services for tourists, such as transport, hotels, restaurants and entertainment.		
landform	A natural feature of the Earth's surface e.g. mountains, rivers etc
