




Vocabulary


fertilisation	The process of the male and female sex cells fusing.
gestation	The process of time when prenatal development takes place before birth.
reproduce	To produce young.
asexual reproduction	A process where one parent produces new life.
sexual reproduction	A process requires a male and a female to produce new life.
Life cycle	The changes a living thing goes through, including reproduction.
metamorphosis	An abrupt and obvious change in an animal's body structure and behaviour.



A butterfly goes through metamorphosis to become an adult.




Living things such as plants contain male and female sex cells. The male (pollen) and the female (ovule) need wind or insects to transfer the pollen to another plant for pollination to occur.
