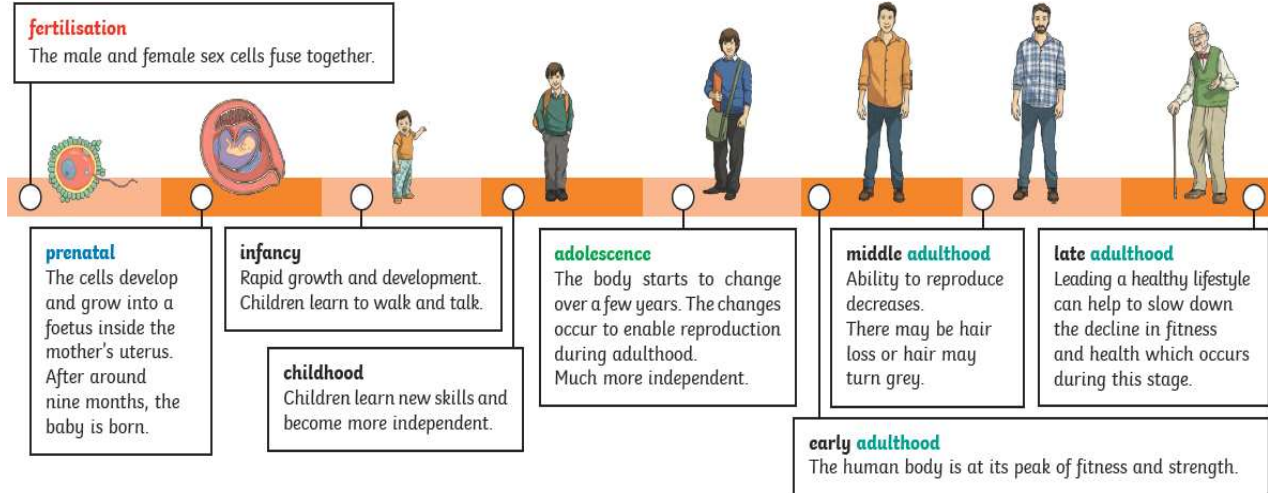
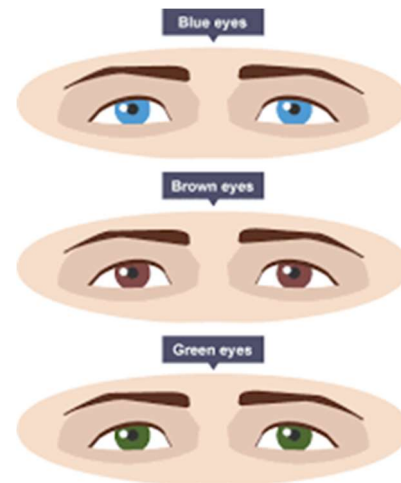


Vocabulary

<b>fertilisation</b>	The process of the male and female sex cells fusing.
<b>gestation</b>	The process of time when prenatal development takes place before birth.
<b>reproduce</b>	To produce young.
<b>asexual reproduction</b>	A process where one parent produces new life.
<b>sexual reproduction</b>	A process requires a male and a female to produce new life.
<b>life cycle</b>	The changes a living thing goes through including reproduction.
<b>adolescence</b>	The social and emotional stage of development between childhood and adulthood.
<b>puberty</b>	The physical stage of development between childhood and adulthood
<b>Life expectancy</b>	The length of time, on average, that a particular animal is expected to live.



Inheritance is when a living thing reproduces and passes on characteristics to their offspring e.g. eye



Variation is the differences between individuals of the same species, caused by genetic and environmental factors.
