




Archaeologists dig up objects from the ground and this helps find out about the past.

Agriculture	Growing crops and raising animals for food, clothing, and other products.
Celts	A group of ancient people who lived in parts of Europe, long before the Romans.
Hillfort	A type of ancient settlement built on a hill.
Homo- sapiens	The human species.
Ice Age	A period of history where part of the Earth was covered in ice.
Mesolithic	Is a period of history known as the Middle Stone Age.
Metal Ore	A type of rock that contains enough of a metal to be extracted and used.
Neanderthal	An ancient species of human that lived in Europe and parts of Asia.
Neolithic	A period of history known as the New Stone Age.
