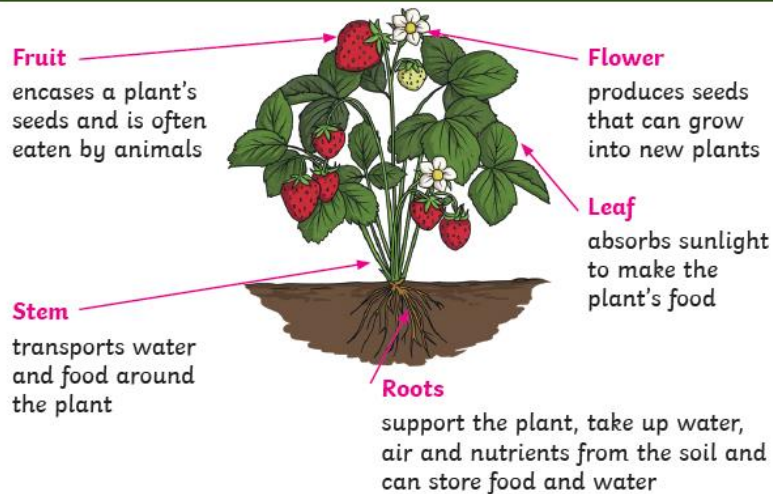

Seed dispersal

Seeds can be spread in lots of different ways, including:

Key Words	Definitions
fertilisation	The process where a seed is produced which can grow into a new plant
germination	The process where a seed starts to grow
nutrients	Substances needed for living things to grow and survive. Most plants gather nutrients from the soil using their roots
pollination	The process where pollen is moved into a flower's stigma
pollinator	An animal which carries pollen between flowers
seed dispersal	When seeds spread away from the parent flower

A **life cycle** of a flowering plant shows the order of how a plant grows. At the end of the cycle, new seeds are **dispersed** and begin to grow which means the cycle starts again.
